Usually, any topic you find interesting is initially too broad for a term paper or thesis, e.g. "Migration in the European Union", "Renewable energy", or "Climate change and energy policies in the 21<sup>st</sup> century". It is important that you narrow down your subject in order to find a proper structure for your thesis – not lose yourself in an enormous pile of literature.

The following categories can help you narrow down a topic.

Try to use as many as you can to formulate your topic as precisely and appropriately as possible:

- a) time frame, e.g. specific era, century, decade, from ... to, ...
- b) (geographic or political) location, e.g. country, city, region, ...
- c) **institution**, e.g. school, university, company, department, ...
- d) group of people, e.g. women, students, children, migrants, engineers, ...
- e) **sources**, e.g. children's movies, advertisements, ...
- f) **important individuals or works**, e.g. Shakespeare's plays, the philosophy of Kant, the relationship between C. S. Lewis and J. R. R. Tolkien, ...
- g) scientific field, e.g. neurolinguistics, experimental physics, microbiology, ...
- h) **specific theories and approaches within your chosen field**, e.g. quantum field theory, class theory, corporate finance theory, ...
- i) **most important researchers in the chosen field**, e.g. an analysis based on Freud's findings, with the focus on the work of Max Weber, ...
- j) **individually chosen aspects**, e.g. focus on what can cause the issue you write about, or on the challenges resulting from it, ...

  - On-the-job training for teachers in extracurricular educational institutions (j)
- 4. The philosophy of Emmanuel Kant:
  - Emmanuel Kant and the Enlightment (a+j)
  - Kant's philosophy between 1780 and 1790 (a)
  - The influence of David Humes on Kant's philosophy (f+j)
